LIVING HISTORY

Our living history encampment is one of our most popular services. We will create a civil war style encampment with reenactors displaying aspects of civilian and military life during the civil war.

Our living history team members are highly skilled and knowledgeable and cover a range of skills including playing the lute, turning wood, embroidery and cooking in a field kitchen.

All of our re-enactors are happy to answer questions from your visitors and explain how civilians lived during the seventeenth century. The living history display will keep your visitors entertained throughout the day.

BATTLE DISPLAYS

Our battle re-enactments are one of the highlights of the day and a definite crowd pleaser!

Our displays include fighting with pikes, muskets and cannons and create lots of noise and smoke helping your visitors understand the uncertainty and confusion that a soldier would face on a seventeenth century battlefield.

We provide a commentator to tell the audience what is happening as the action unfolds and to explain the use of the drums and colours on the battlefield. The battle will be scripted in advance to be in line with your requirements, and, if relevant, reflect any local historical skirmishes.





DRILL DISPLAYS

In addition to the battle, our re-enactors can also present a drill display to demonstrate how seventeenth century weapons work and how a soldier would use them in combat.

We provide a commentator to explain the steps that the soldier would go through to load and fire their weapons, the tactics and role played by the pike block and the significance of the drum calls in a battlefield situation.

A drill display is an excellent complement to a larger battle display as it allows your visitors to learn about the types of weapons and tactics used prior to seeing them used in action later in the day.

EDUCATION

As a society, one of our key aims is to raise the profile of the English Civil War; this is an often an overlooked period despite being one of the most destructive an devastating conflicts in British history.

The English Civil War is part of the national curriculum at KS3 and a popular option for GCSE and A-level study. We can provide an experience that can complement these areas of study.

As part of our event, we can provide activities for children including children's drill and activity trails around our living history camp to encourage them to talk to our re-enactors and ask questions.

A suitable number of re-enactors for the size of your event.


- Entertainment for your visitors throughout the day


